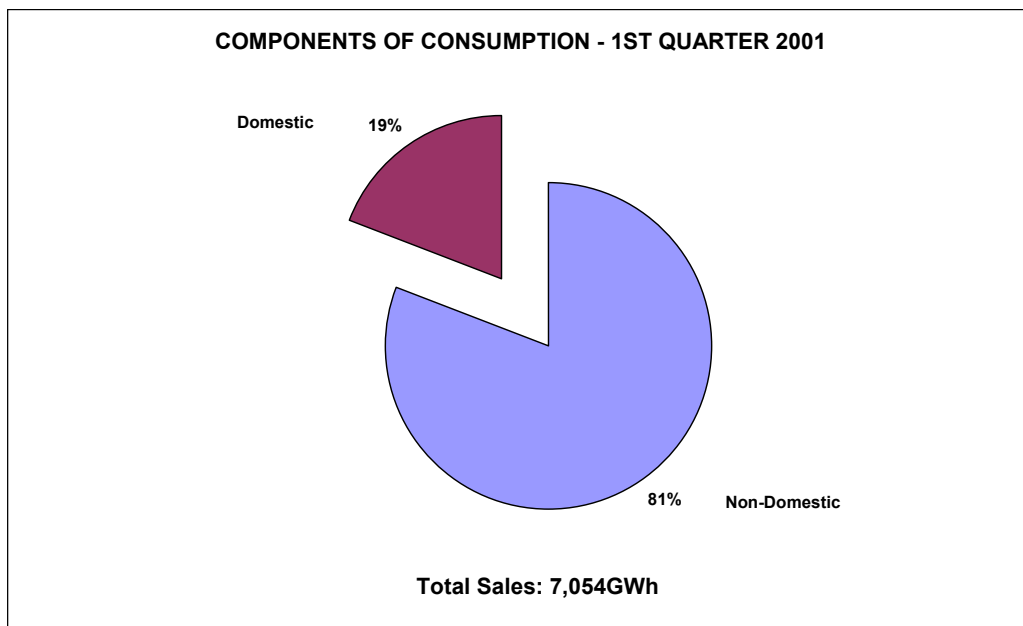
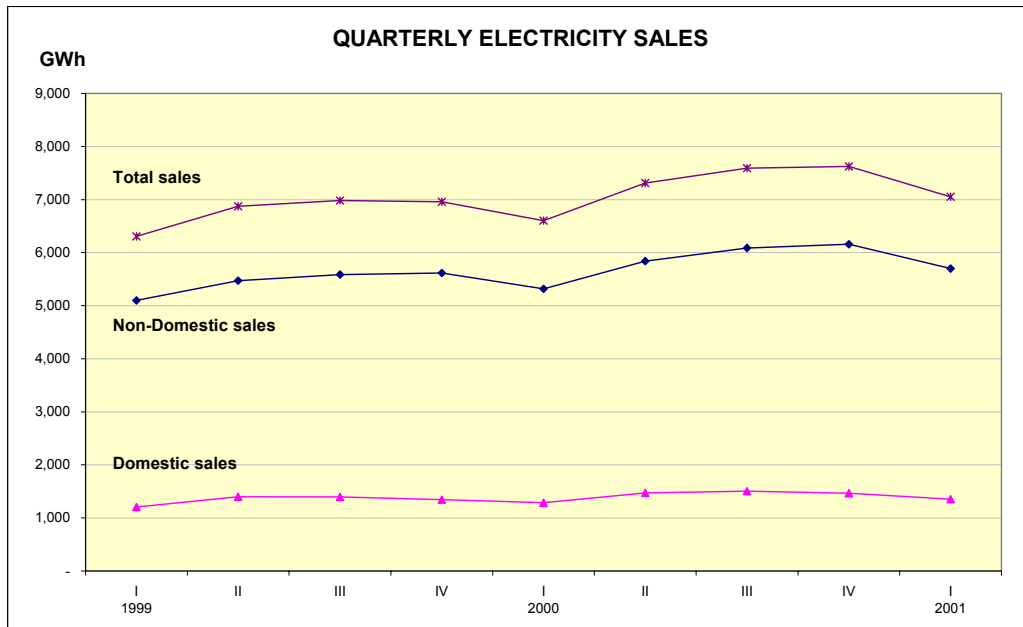


Sale of Electricity

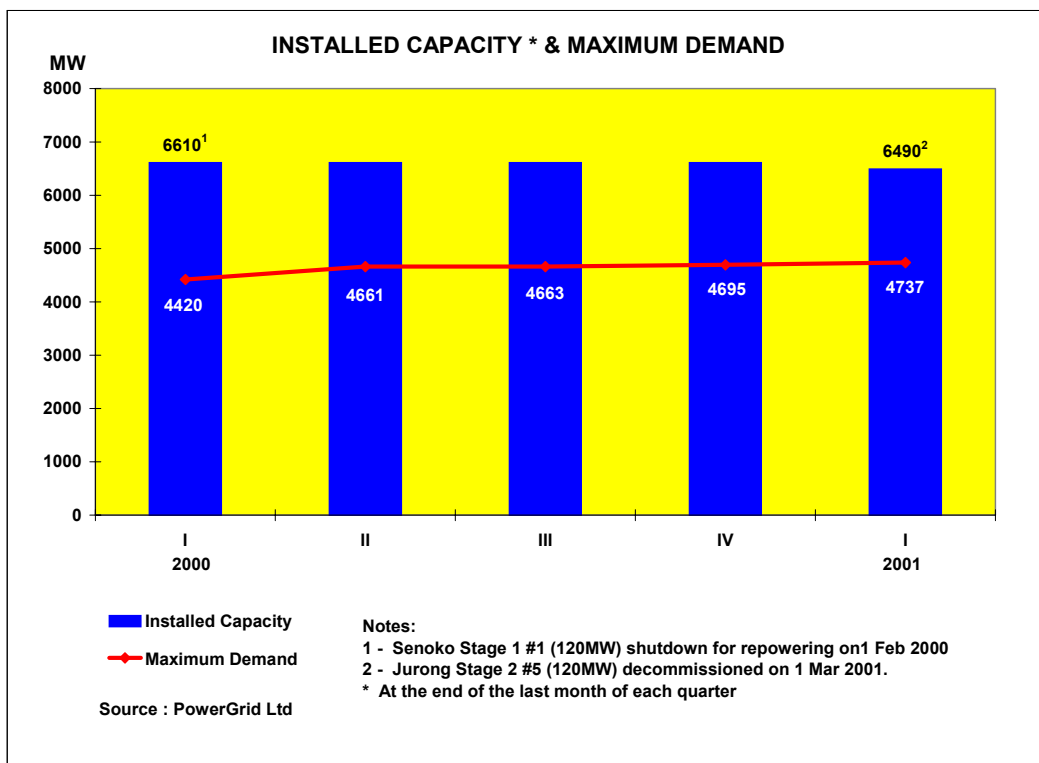
The electricity sales in 1st quarter 2001 increased by 6.8% to 7,054GWh, over the same quarter last year. The increase was mainly due to the 7.2% growth in non-domestic sales, which accounted for 81% of total sales. Sales to domestic customers grew by 5.4%.



Details of changes in consumption by the various sectors are shown below:

• Domestic	↑ 5.4% over 1 st quarter 2000
• Non-Domestic	↑ 7.2% over 1 st quarter 2000

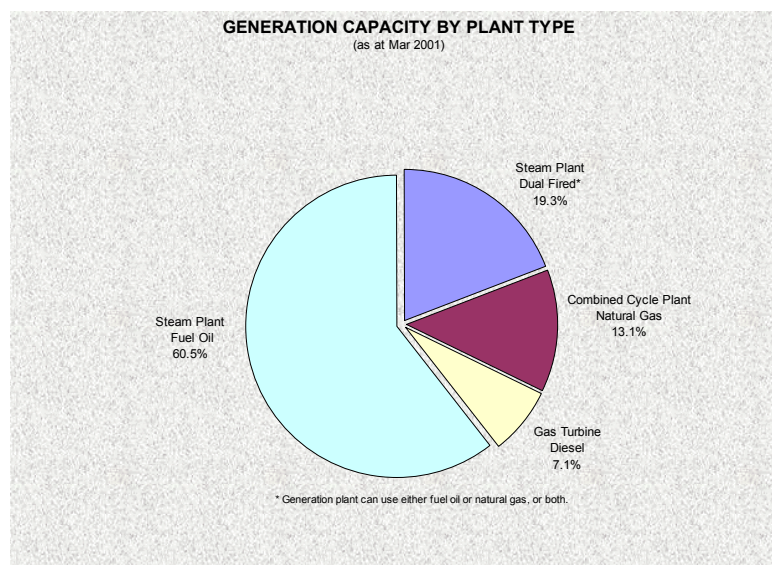
Installed Capacity & Maximum Demand - First Quarter 2001



As at March 2001, total generation capacity was 6,490MW due to the retirement of Jurong steam plant.

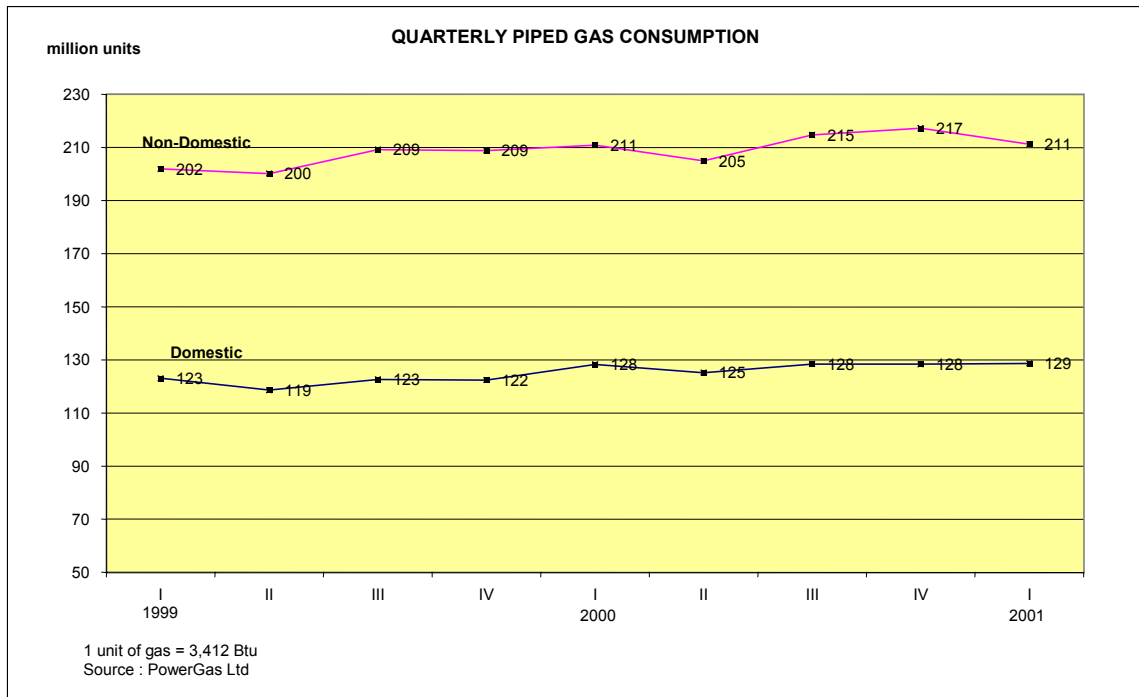
The generating units of ExxonMobil, SembCorp Cogen and Senoko Power were still undergoing commissioning tests during the reporting period.

There was adequate generation capacity to meet the minimum reserve margin and the maximum demand of 4,737 MW in first quarter of 2001. The maximum demand in the first quarter of 2001 was 7.2% higher than the maximum demand in the same period in 2000.



Piped-Gas Industry

PowerGas Ltd is the public gas licensee providing piped gas for consumers in Singapore. In the 1st quarter of 2001, consumption of piped-gas amounted to 340 million units, 0.2% higher as compared to 1st quarter 2000. Non-domestic consumers accounted for 62% of total sales.
