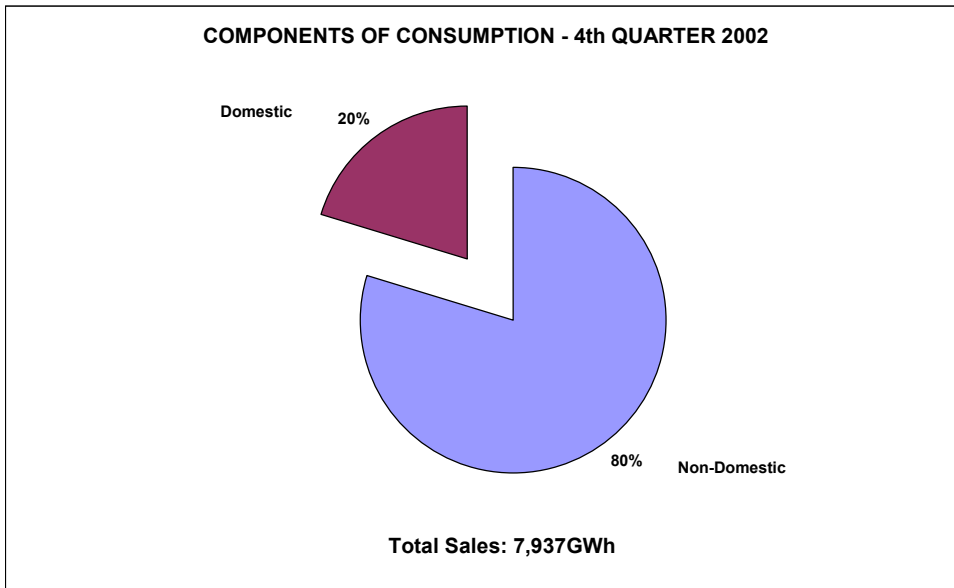
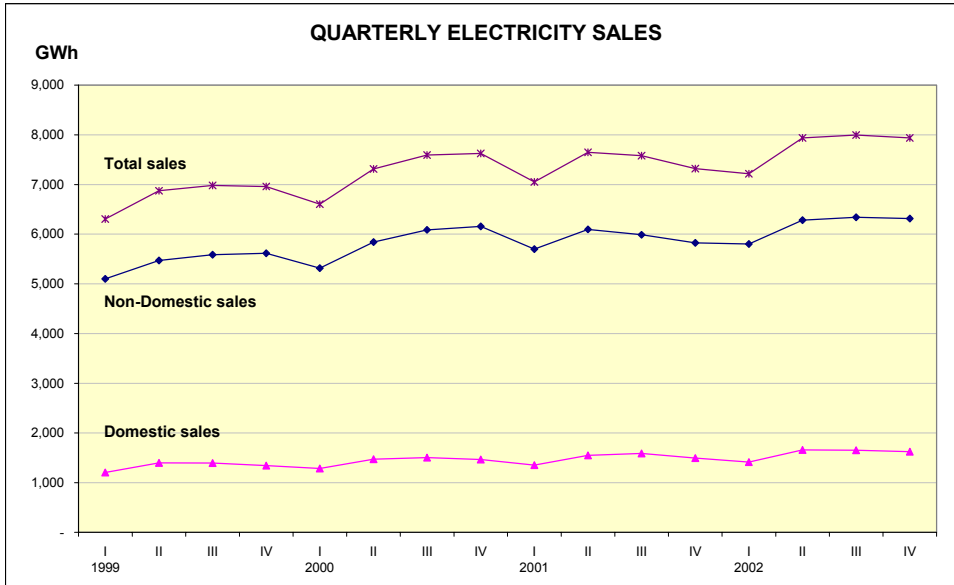


## Sale of Electricity

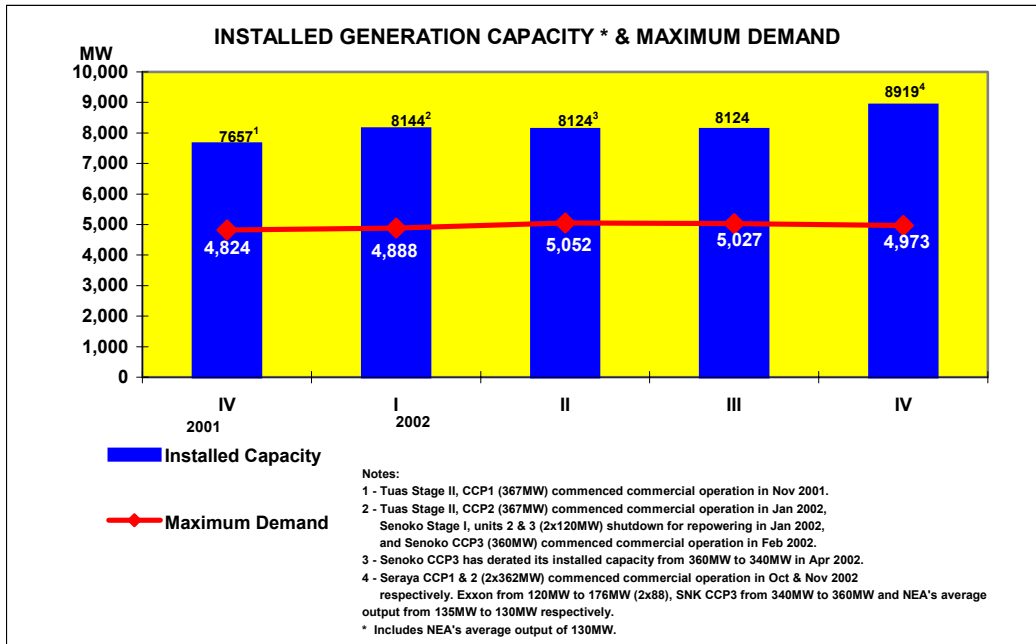
The electricity sales in 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2002 increased by 8.5% to 7,937GWh over the same quarter last year. The increase was due to a 8.4% and 8.6% rise in non-domestic and domestic sales respectively. Non-domestic sales accounted for 80% of total sales.



Details of changes in consumption by sectors are shown below:

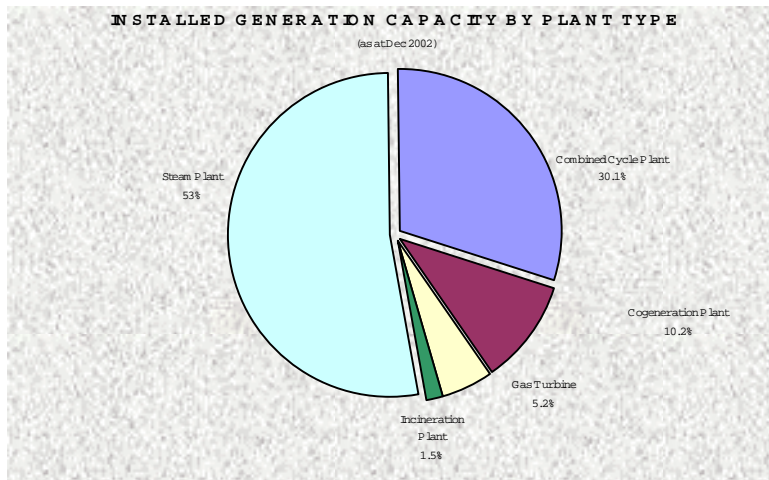
Domestic	↑	8.6% over 4 <sup>th</sup> quarter 2001

## Installed Capacity & Maximum Demand - Fourth Quarter 2002



Note: National Environment Agency (NEA) generates electricity from incineration plant.

As at Dec 2002, total installed generation capacity of system was 8,919MW. There was adequate installed generation capacity to meet the minimum reserve margin and the maximum demand of 4,973 MW in fourth quarter of 2002. The maximum demand in the fourth quarter of 2002 was 3.1% higher than the maximum demand for the same quarter in 2001.



## Piped-Gas Industry

In the 4th quarter of 2002, PowerGas' piped gas sales amounted to 351 million units, 2.2% higher than the same quarter in 2001.
