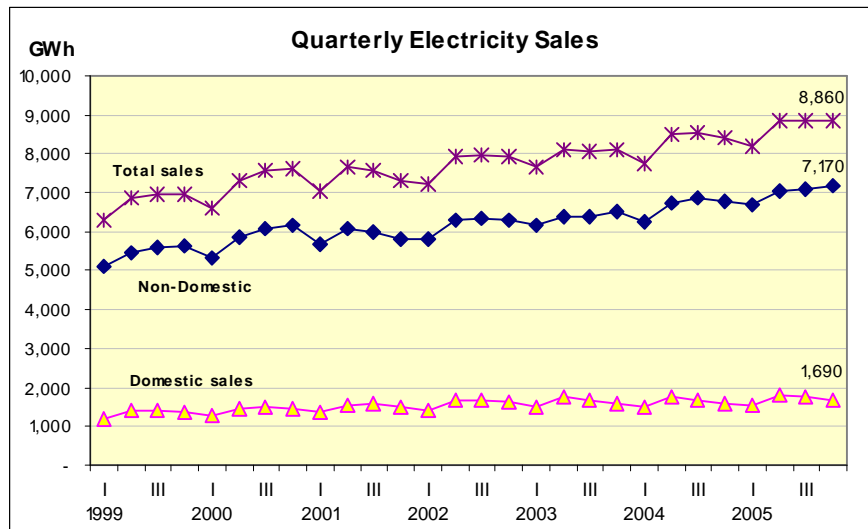
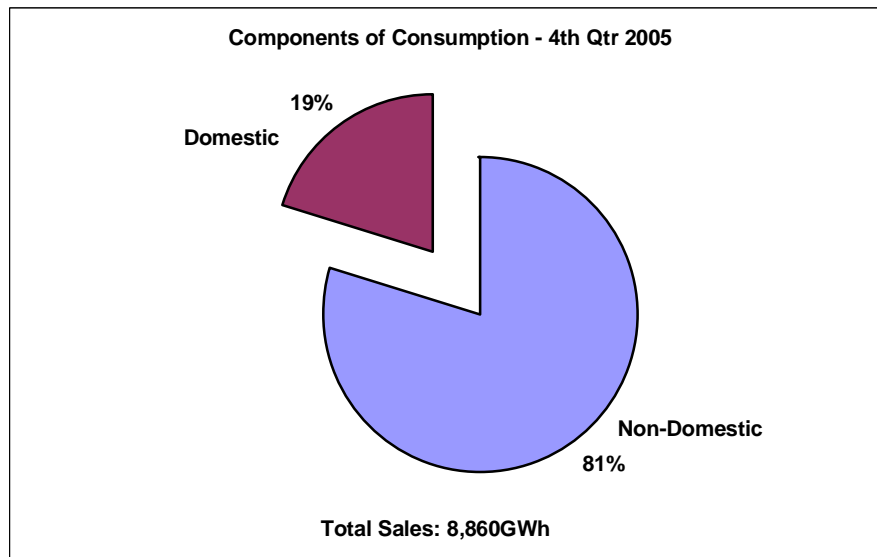


Sale of Electricity

The electricity sales in 4th quarter 2005 increased by 5.6% to 8,860GWh over the same period last year. This was due to increases of 5.6% and 5.2% in non-domestic and domestic (i.e. households) sales respectively. Sales to non-domestic and domestic consumers accounted for 81% and 19% of total electricity sales, respectively.



Details of changes in consumption by sectors are shown below:

Piped-Gas Industry
