ELECTRICITY SAFETY TIPS

LOVED ONES SAFE!

Do Keep electricity and water apart

Do ensure the earth wire (green/yellow) is connected to the Earth terminal

Do NOT use damaged equipment or frayed/broken cable cords. Replace immediately

Do NOT overload power points

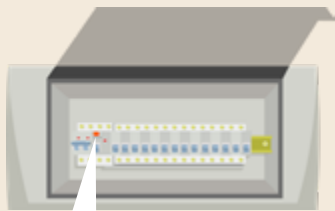

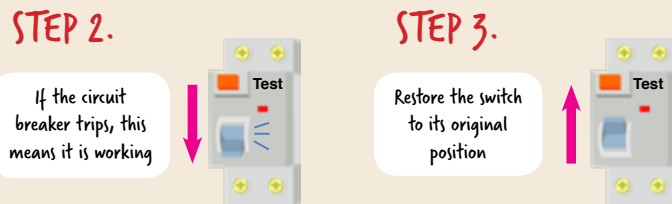
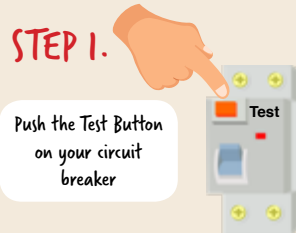

FOLLOW THESE TIPS TO BEGIN ELECTRICAL SAFETY IN YOUR HOME

Tip #1:
TEST YOUR RESIDUAL CURRENT CIRCUIT BREAKER MONTHLY!



Locate the test button on your circuit breaker

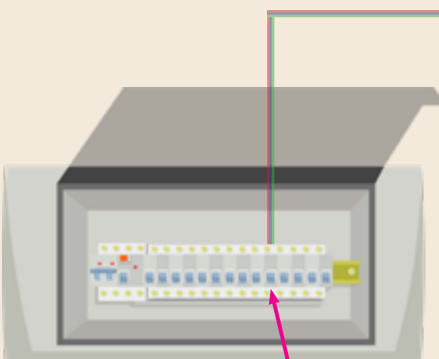


Call a licensed electrical worker immediately if the circuit breaker does not trip

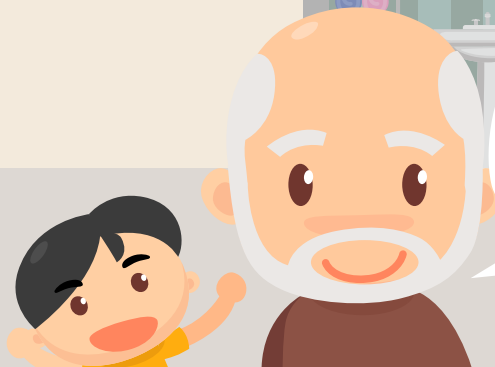
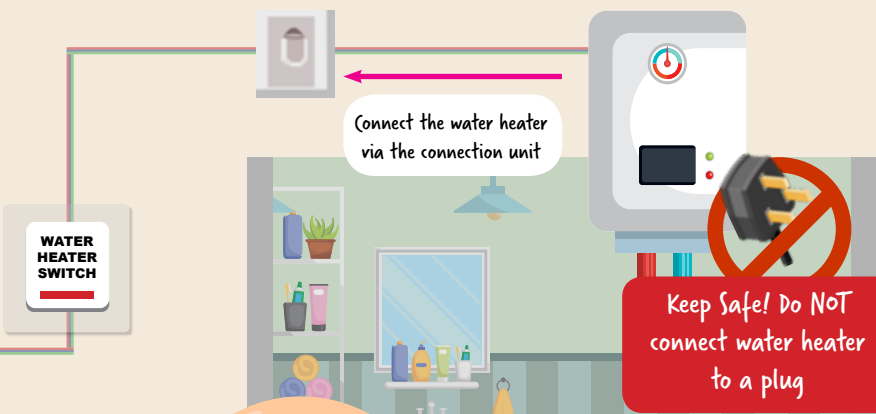


A working circuit breaker cuts off electricity in case of electricity leakage. This is to protect our home and loved ones!

Tip #2:
ENSURE YOUR WATER HEATER IS INSTALLED CORRECTLY!



Connect a separate circuit for your electrical water heater



Do Not connect your water heater to a plug as water heater draws high current! If unsure, consult a licensed electrical worker.

Always engage a **Licensed Electrical Worker** to carry out electrical work
