1. Pursuant to Condition 2 of the Gas Licence for LNG Terminal Operator Licensee (Licence No. EMA/LNGTO/001) ("Licence") granted to Singapore LNG Corporation Pte Ltd ("SLNG"), SLNG is hereby notified that Energy Market Authority has approved the application of SLNG to introduce Storage and Reload Services using its spare terminal capacity as Other Regulated Services subject to the following conditions:

- a. that SLNG can own up to an inventory of 6,000m<sup>3</sup> of LNG from the provision of Storage and Reload Services;
- b. that such inventory shall only be used for the purpose of the provision of Storage and Reload Services; and
- c. that SLNG shall ensure that the provision of the Storage and Reload Services will not adversely affect SLNG's provision of throughput services under the Licence.

2. Accordingly, Schedule 3 of the Licence is deleted and substituted with the Schedule 3 in the Annex.

3. The Notification shall come into effect on the date set out below.

**SCHEDULE 3:****Other Regulated Services of the LNG Terminal**

	<p>Other Regulated Services means any one or more or all of the following:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) the Cool-down Services using the Residual Commissioning LNG;</li> <li>(ii) the Storage and Reload Services using the Licensee's spare terminal capacity;</li> <li>(iii) any Other Regulated Services as introduced by the Licensee and approved by the Authority</li> </ul> <p><b>"Cool-down Services"</b> means one or more of the following:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. the drying of LNG ship tanks;</li> <li>b. the purging of air from LNG ship tanks with inert gas;</li> <li>c. the gassing-up of LNG ship tanks;</li> <li>d. the cool-down of LNG ship tanks to the required temperature; and/or</li> <li>e. the loading of LNG into LNG ship tanks to provide the tanks with the required heel.</li> </ul> <p><b>"Residual Commissioning LNG"</b> means the remaining balance of any LNG inventory used for the commissioning of any equipment of the LNG Terminal as approved by the Authority.</p> <p><b>"Storage and Reload Services"</b> means the following: -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. the provision of one or more jetty slots to a Storage and Reload Customer for the berthing of LNG ships for the unloading of LNG cargo;</li> <li>b. the receipt of such unloaded LNG cargo from LNG ships;</li> <li>c. the storage of such unloaded LNG for a specific period of time;</li> <li>d. the provision of one or more jetty slots to a Storage and Reload Customer for the berthing of LNG ships for the reloading of the stored LNG;</li> <li>e. the pumping and reloading of LNG onto LNG ships;</li> <li>f. the assignment of the LNG inventory of a Storage and Reload Customer to other Storage and Reload Customers, as agreed between them; and</li> </ul>
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g. associated services such as measurement, testing and accounting of LNG inventory.

**"Storage and Reload Customer"** means a customer receiving Storage and Reload Services from the Licensee.

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
