We generally support the proposed amendments to the Gas Act (Cap.116A) to facilitate open access to gas pipeline infrastructure and competition in the gas industry.

After several years of consultative work with industry players, it is timely to move forward. With open access to pipeline infrastructure and level playing competition, it is likely to benefit consumers with greater levels of efficiency in the industry and price competitiveness.

The proposed changes also empower the Authority to allow shippers to pass through such fees or other charges under the Gas Network Code to ensure the reliability, availability and continuity of the supply of gas. This highlights that gas consumers do and have to play their role.
