Dear Leow Leng Chong and Lilian Lau,

Further to your "Request for Feedback" and relevant paper published on the EMA website on 13 February we would like to provide some comment. As I'm sure you are aware Premier Oil is an active player in the regional gas industry and is a major contributor to pipeline gas supplies into Singapore.

We strongly support EMA's moves to create "open competitive access to gas pipeline infrastructure" ("Request for Feedback" paper paragraph 2) and we have read with care paragraph 12 referring to "...users to enable third party access.." of the same document. However, we believe that measures to impose a gas allocation system (where none is previously agreed) would be incomplete if it did not also include a requirement to provide for published non-discriminatory tariff charges for use of all parts of the Singapore gas pipeline system including offshore pipelines.

We would like to thank EMA for providing industry an opportunity to take part in the consultative process and we look forward to working closely with you in the future.
