Operational readiness of retailers to serve OEM Consumers	A retailer will only be allowed to commence retailing to OEM Consumers after it has satisfied EMA of its operational readiness in terms of IT system as well as ability to comply with EMA's regulatory requirements.	<p>2.1.2 A Licensee shall not retail electricity to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) any consumer who is not classified or is not qualified to be classified as a contestable consumer under the Electricity (Contestable Consumers) Regulations; and (b) any consumer who is classified or is qualified to be classified as a contestable consumer under the Electricity (Contestable Consumers) Regulations and meets one of the following conditions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) the consumer is a residential consumer; or (ii) the consumer is a non-residential consumer with an aggregate electricity consumption of 2,000 kilowatt-hour or less, <p>unless the Licensee is specifically approved by the Authority to do so.</p>
